



Annual Fellers' Cake Bake Contest Announcement & Rules



Traditionally this event is for Cub Scouts and their dads to take a stab at making a cake they can both be proud of. In this day and age, there are some rules that are set in stone and some that are set in dough! For our Pack Cake Bake we will encourage the boys to work with a male role model, but if one is not readily available we will happily allow the boy to use their mom for advice and guidance. Remember this is a project for the boys! The adult should be there to assist and handle the oven part, but let the boys have fun creating something wonderful. This is an annual celebration of the birthday of scouting. What better way to celebrate than by baking a cake?!

Purpose: The purpose of the Fellers' Cake Bake Contest is threefold:

1. To provide all Cub Scouts and their male friends and associates (like brothers, dads, grandpas, uncles, etc.) an opportunity and excuse to wreak havoc on their kitchens. (All Scouts must help clean up!)
2. To attempt to create a gourmet dessert to celebrate the birthday of scouting.
3. To win a ribbon for having tried your dangdest to make a cake that looks, sounds, smells, feels, and tastes edible.

Prizes: Every boy who participates will earn a special patch. Prizes will be awarded for four categories. Everyone will be recognized for his creation and have a chance to celebrate the birthday of scouting.

Cakes will be judged in the following categories:

- Best “Deep Sea Adventure” theme**
- Best “Pirate Adventure” theme**
- Most original creation**
- Best “Cub Scout” theme**
- People’s Choice Award**

Additional awards may be made at the judges' discretion.

All cakes must follow the official rules to qualify for awards.

Boys should wear Class A Uniforms.



Feller's Cake Bake Rules

Cake Rules:

- Cakes must be baked by a Tiger Cub, Cub Scout, or Webelos Scout with the assistance of a parent, older sibling, grandparent, etc.
- Cake mixes and icing mixes are allowed.
- The entire creation must be edible—that includes decorations and structural reinforcement. (No, toothpicks and/or straws are not edible unless you are a termite.)
- All cakes should have a title or name—to be shown on a 3 x 5 inch card. Please **only** put the scout's name on the **BACK** of the card.
- As the cakes will be served at the end, please bring something to cut and serve your cake. All cakes will be shared at the end of the meeting as the refreshment.
- Cakes must be at the Cake Bake by 6:00 p.m. Doors open at 5:30 p.m.
- Each cake will be assigned a number at registration.
