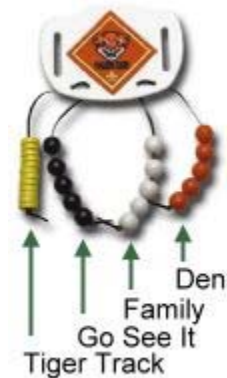


II. Achievements and Beads

Each of the Five Tiger Achievements has three activities: Family, Den, and Go See It. Each activity earns a bead.

- White Beads for “Family”
- Orange Beads for “Den”
- Black Beads for “Go See It”
- Gold Tiger Tracks (Electives)



III. Completing all 15 activities will qualify the Tiger for his Tiger Cub Badge. This Signifies he has earned the Tiger Cub Rank



IV. Electives and Tiger Track Beads (pg. 71-142)

After Earning his Tiger Cub Badge, your Tiger may earn Yellow Track Beads for completing elective activities. There are 50 activities listed in the handbook starting on page 71. For every 10 electives your Tiger earns 1 Track bead.

V. Bobcat (pg. 152)

Every new Scout, regardless of entering rank, must earn their Bobcat badge before they be awarded their Wolf, Bear, or Webelo badge. For Tiger Scouts, the 8 step Bobcat Trail begins after they have earned their Tiger badge.
