

Wolf Cubs (2nd Grade or 8 Years Old)

I) Bobcat (Pages 16 – 35)

Every new Scout regardless of their entering rank must earn their Bobcat badge before receiving any other rank.



II) Wolf Trail (Pages 38 – 107)

The Wolf Trail has 12 achievements that must be completed to earn The Wolf Rank. Each achievement is considered complete when all the requirements (activities) are met. On Page 234, there is a handy summary chart for keeping track of completed activities. Please note that achievements 1, 10, and 12 contain optional activities.

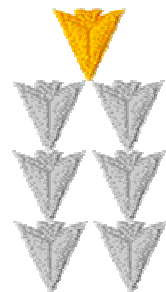
III) Progress Toward Ranks

After your Wolf has completed his first three achievements, he will be awarded his Progress Toward Ranks Emblem and first Gold Bead. For every three achievements, he will receive another Gold Bead. When he has earned 4 Gold Beads (completed all 12 achievements) he will have earned his Wolf Badge "Made Rank".



IV) Arrow Point Trail (Pages 109 – 125)

There are 23 electives in the Wolf handbook covering a total of 129 elective projects. After completing 10 projects, a gold arrow point is awarded. For every 10 projects after that, a silver arrow point is awarded. A tracking chart for electives is on pages 236-237.
